2. Turn Left onto E Kalastie Saloom Rd 2.9miles
3. Turn Right onto Steiner Rd .3miles
4. Turn Left onto Silverstone Rd .2miles
5. Turn Right onto Elysian Fields Dr
6. End at 221 Elysian Fields Dr

From Eunice, Ville Platte, Natchitoches:

1. I-49 South to SW Evangeline Trwy (I-49 turns into SW Evangeline Trwy)
2. Turn Right onto E Kalastie Saloom Rd 2.9miles
3. Turn Right onto Steiner Rd .3miles
4. Turn Left onto Silverstone Rd .2miles
5. Turn Right onto Elysian Fields Dr
6. End at 221 Elysian Fields Dr

From Baton Rouge:

1. I-10 West toward Lafayette
2. Merge onto US 167 South via Exit 103A
3. US 167 S becomes SW Evangeline Trwy
4. Turn Right onto E Kalastie Saloom Rd 2.9miles
5. Turn Right onto Steiner Rd .3miles
6. Turn Left onto Silverstone Rd .2miles
7. Turn Right onto Elysian Fields Dr
8. End at 221 Elysian Fields Dr

2007 Adult Tri-Level State Tournament Regulations
Lafayette, LA 11/17/07

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Current USTA membership.

PLAYER AGREEMENT: All players participating in the USTA Tri-Level State Tournament, as a condition of their participation, agree to abide and be bound by the USTA Constitution and By-laws, USTA League Tennis Regulations, the Rules of Tennis (unless modified by these USTA League Tennis Regulations); the USTA League Tennis Regulations and the standards of good conduct, fair play and good sportsmanship (N1.12)

TEAM CHECK-IN: Team captains are required to check in their team at the tournament headquarters (River Ranch) prior to their first match.

TOURNAMENT FEE: The 2007 state tournament fee is \$20.00 per player and is due on or before the first scheduled team match.

TEAM MATCH SCHEDULE: Team captains are responsible for confirming their next match time with the site director after each and every team match.

MATCH WARM-UP: A ten (10) minute warm up will be observed with a fifteen (15) minute default. Lateness penalties will be assessed as outlined in Friend at Court.

SCORING & REST: Matches will be 8 game pro sets with a tie break at 7-all (1st to 7 winning by a margin of 2). The championship committee may authorize alternate scoring at any time during the tournament to complete team matches.N3.03C

COMPETITION FORMAT: Round robin format shall be used for the tournament. The team with the most team points shall be the champion.

A team point will be awarded to the team who wins the majority of the individual team matches. N3.03D. The procedures outlined in the National regulations (3.03I) will be followed in the event of a tie; winner of most individual matches, loser of fewest games, winner of head-to-head or *coin toss*.

CELLULAR PHONES: The tournament referee has banned the use of cell phones during tournament matches. Players must turn off their cell phones prior to the start of their match. Cell phone rings during a match will result in a point penalty for the first offense, a game penalty for the second offense and a default for the third offense.
